



## **PRESS RELEASE: NON-SUBSCRIBER LOCATION REQUEST**

The AirFlare team is pleased to announce the release of Non-Subscriber Location Request – the ability for a search team, and most commonly dispatch, to send a location return request via text to a mobile phone with or without AirFlare installed. Upon receipt and approval, the phone automatically pulls its GPS coordinates into a reply text back to the search team.

Callers in self-initiated assistance call scenarios frequently do not know how to describe their location, or how to direct searchers to them. Non-Subscriber Location Request enables a lost subject's exact GPS coordinates to be sent back to the search team with a simple push of a button, regardless whether the subject has AirFlare on their phone.

Additionally, Non-AirFlare Subscriber Location Request offers another powerful mechanism for search teams to notify someone they are the subject of a search, which can be helpful in false-alarm scenarios.

Non-Subscriber Location Request is available now in Field Console version 1.4 or later.
