



PRESS RELEASE: AIRFLARE WEB CONSOLE

The AirFlare team is pleased to announce the release of Web Console – a PC based version of Field Console used by search teams to configure, control and manage AirFlare Search Technology from a desktop or laptop computer.

Previous versions of AirFlare required search team personnel to operate AirFlare Search Technology via Field Console downloaded to an IOS or Android phone or tablet. During the 2018/19 pilot at Crystal Mountain Resort, Patrol Director Peter Dale and Assistant Patrol Director Brent Okita pointed out that dispatchers do much of their work from a desktop computer, and encouraged the AirFlare team to develop a PC based option which would better integrate into mountain patrol dispatch operating procedures.

Web Console makes it easier for dispatch to perform the most common AirFlare Search Technology operations such as Registry Search, Location Return, Non-AirFlare Subscriber Location Request, and viewing lost subject GPS coordinates on a map. Web Console in the dispatch center also communicates seamlessly with all search team member's instances of Field Console out in the field, sharing search initiation and search result information across the team in real time.
